

Northern Trails - Fourth of July

About the release

With this third single of the year Northern Trails return to their Americana roots with an acoustically driven track featuring powerfully stacked vocals and racing energetic drums.

Fourth of July is probably the most romantic song from Northern Trails by the time of writing. It was written as the story of an old man brought up to trust noone and to reject the concept of love. As he wakes up from a car accident, he



realizes (with a little help) that he has spent his life in loneliness.

The cover art for *Fourth of July* was made by Uppsala artist Fredrik Hardenborg. Fredrik drew inspiration to this piece from the American painter Edward Hopper, who himself explored loneliness and solitude in his work.

About Northern Trails

Rooted in Americana, 90s Britpop and Swedish indie pop tradition, Northern Trails has a way of presenting timeless melancholic melodies in traditional pop and rock costumes decorated with genre-crossing pearls.

The band was formed in Uppsala, Sweden in May 2022 when Christer Tinnerholm and Thomas Isberg agreed to focus a little less on ultra running and more on pop music. Together with friends Per Larsson och Ulf Eklund they put <u>Hearts</u> <u>Went Frozen EP</u> on tape and released it in November 2023. Thomas Strömbom enjoyed the single <u>AQ</u> on the radio and asked the band if they needed a keyboard player, and Northern Trails has ever since performed as a quintet.
