About Northern Trails

Rooted in Americana, 90s Britpop and Swedish indie pop tradition, Northern Trails has a way of presenting timeless melancholic melodies in traditional pop and rock costumes decorated with genre-crossing pearls.

The band was formed in Uppsala, Sweden in May 2022 when Christer Tinnerholm and Thomas Isberg agreed to focus a little less on ultra running and more on pop music. Together with friends Per Larsson och Ulf Eklund they put <u>Hearts</u> <u>Went Frozen EP</u> on tape and released it in November 2023. Thomas Strömbom enjoyed the single <u>AQ</u> on the radio and asked the band if they needed a keyboard player, and Northern Trails has ever since performed as a quintet.
